

Hope everyone is staying safe. As news swirls about a second wave coming and with MoL gearing up to blitz the job sites I wanted to remind everyone of the COVID protocols at all Losani sites.

Losani Homes is continually taking extra precautionary measures for the health and safety of our homeowners, trade partners and employees. At the present time, health authorities are encouraging individuals and businesses to take certain measures to reduce interactions to help slow the spread of COVID 19. At this present time, we are operating and continuing to provide service throughout our company as safely and efficiently as possible. Please see below list of measures that we have taken and are asking you and your staff to follow.

- All site trailers will be remained closed to everyone until further notice
- Additional toilets and wash stations have been added throughout all sites and are being cleaned on a daily basis
- **No more than one trade working on a house at any given time. Our construction schedules have reflected this. If someone is in the house at your scheduled time please contact the site supervisor**
- Losani staff are to wear gloves and masks at all times
- Virus Protection literature is posted on all houses under construction
- Cleaning of all homes now includes a product used on all hard surfaces and door handles. This is a product that keeps the surfaces sanitized for 24 hours even after multiple touches
- All meetings are to take place via video/phone call or postponed until further notice

Furthermore, we have implemented the following measures and are asking everyone to follow:

- All site trailers will be remained closed to everyone until further notice. Check in with the site supervisor by call, email or text
- Social Distancing is to be maintained at all times which includes:
 - You are not to be within 2 metres of another individual
 - No car pooling with other employees or trades
 - No physical interactions (handshakes, huddles, group lunches)
 - Communicate with other staff and trades via phone and not in person
- Proper Hygiene – hand washing, cough/sneeze into the bend of your arm
- Keep all tools and materials clean and sanitized
- Avoid touching commonly touched surfaces
- After PDI, you may only enter the home if you are wearing gloves, a mask and booties
- If any staff member is feeling ill or is experiencing any flu like symptoms, we ask that you remain off all Losani job sites
- Ensure that any person who has travelled, or has come into contact with anyone travelling, out of the country in the last 14 days remains off all Losani job sites or come in contact with any other employee

We will be updating everyone shortly over our site check in procedures.

We remain committed to the protocols and guidelines recommended by Public Health and we will continue to monitor the situation and make any changes as they are required. We are here to meet the needs of our customers and trade partners, and we thank you for your cooperation as we navigate through this time together.

We ask that you please share the information provided with your staff that will be on Losani Homes job sites during this time.
